As a district, to increase student academic growth and achievement, the following supports and measures have been added to the North Central Area Schools.

The district has made improvements to curriculum in the areas of Math and Reading, at the elementary level. We have added additional adult support in various areas to maintain a robust academic, social and emotional support system for our students. In K-5 we have implemented Bookworms, an ELA curriculum. Bookworms is research-based, differentiates instruction at the foundational skills level rather than the text level to help students accelerate their reading growth. Students build knowledge and learn vocabulary by reading a wide range of themes and topics. Bookworms is designed for students to read a high volume of words every day and is centered around excellent, whole text selections.
